A year after Qassem Soleimani's assassination, Iran and US edge close to conflict

The anniversary and an outgoing US president with little to lose could prove a tipping point for tensions between Tehran and Washington. In Washington, there is frenzied worry about an Iranian revenge attack, likely carried out in Iraq, and equally frenetic apparent attempts by officials to de-escalate. United States warships and bombers have skirted past Iran in what American officials have described as shows of force against Tehran, while other armadas have been redeployed. The United States and Iran have ratcheted up their decades-long confrontation to a degree rare in recent history, just 20 days before the administration of Donald Trump is set to leave office, triggering fears of a potential armed conflict. "Some friendly health advice to Iran," Mr Trump wrote on Christmas Eve, days after a barrage of rockets presumably fired by pro-Iranian Iraqi militias struck near the US embassy in Baghdad and initiated the latest round of tensions between Tehran and Washington.

COMMENT

There is speculation that Trump in his dying days of office could trigger a war with Iran. Fuel was added to this fire when Mr Trump cut short his annual New Year's Eve visit to his Florida resort and rushed back to Washington, followed by vice president Mike Pence, who cancelled a planned trip to Israel. In the closing months of 2020, the US sent 2,000 more troops and an additional squadron of fighter jets to Saudi Arabia, and flew three long-distance B-52 bomber missions near Iran. In Isaiah 13 we read of the Medes (Iranians) being stirred up. They use their bows (missiles). They attack Babylon (Iraq). We know that Isaiah had an initial fulfilment in ancient times but there is also a latter day fulfilment that could possibly play out very soon....

Tehran flexes Palestinian muscle with Gaza rocket exercise out to sea

The Gaza-based radical Palestinian Jihad and Hamas on Tuesday, Dec. 29 staged a joint rocket exercise out to sea – carefully pointed away from the Israeli border. The two Palestinian terrorist groups openly activated their joint war room for the first time and in, another first, tested a Hamas drone. (See picture.) This exercise was in keeping with the watchword of muscle-flexing combined-with-prudent caution that a jittery Tehran has circulated to all foreign proxies, lest President Donald Trump or US allies are provoked into a direct attack on Iran before he bows out on Jan. 23. With Iranian financial and military backing, the Jihad terrorists have often loosed their rockets with deadly effect against Israel. However, these days in the last weeks of the Trump presidency, Tehran is accentuating its Palestinian surrogates' preparedness for a direct US or allied attack, while holding back from action that may provoke one.

COMMENT

Iran is under huge pressure to retaliate for the assassination of its top nuclear scientist a few weeks ago and the assassination last year of its top military commander. One place Iran could strike is Iraq where the US still has a base. The other area it could cause trouble is with Israel. Iran controls Hamas and Hezbollah — both terrorist organisations dedicated to destroy Israel. Iran supplies them both with rockets and recently precision missiles. The military exercises this week are intended to show Trump that they are ready if he decides to launch any attack. Psalm 83 says that there is an initial inner ring conflict with Israel by tribes that surround Israel. But they are backed by a nation — Assur. Assur could well refer to Iran. The next few weeks could be significant....

New era for UK as it completes separation from European Union

A new era has begun for the United Kingdom after it completed its formal separation from the European Union. The UK stopped following EU rules at 23:00 GMT, as replacement arrangements for travel, trade, immigration and security co-operation came into force. Boris Johnson said the UK had "freedom in our hands" and the ability to do things "differently and better" now the long Brexit process was over. But opponents of leaving the EU maintain the country will be worse off. Under the new arrangements, UK manufacturers will have tariff-free access to the EU's internal market, meaning there will be no import taxes on goods crossing between Britain and the continent. But it does mean more paperwork for businesses and people travelling to EU countries, while there is still uncertainty about what will happen to banking and services.

COMMENT

Britain left the European Union on Jan. 31 2020 and has been in a transitional period applying most EU economic regulations. The new deal governs trading rules when the transition ended on Dec. 31. The agreement provides for zero-tariff, zero-quota trade in goods and allows trade in some services to continue with minimal restriction. The agreement allows the UK to strike trade deals with other nations. This is very much like ancient Tyre. Tyre was the capital city of Phoenicia. They traded with many nations and became very wealthy. Tyre came to an end when they turned against Israel. Isaiah 23 says that when Tyre came to an end it would "pass over to Tarshish". Tarshish is Britain. So Britain would have a capital city like Tyre – trading with many nations. London became this city and became centre of a worldwide trading empire. It wants to do so again. But God says that Britain will NOT keep her wealth – she is going to lose it...

Russia announces new tit-for-tat sanctions on UK nationals over Alexei Navalny poisoning

Russia has announced an extended travel ban on a number of British nationals in retaliation to UK sanctions over the poisoning of Kremlin critic Alexei Navalny. The Russian Foreign Ministry summoned the UK ambassador, Deborah Bronnert, on Wednesday to announce that certain British nationals would be "denied entry" to the country. While the Ministry has not named the individuals affected, the statement added that the expanded list included "those who are involved in escalating anti-Russian sanctions activities". The travel ban comes after the UK and European Union imposed sanctions on six Russian officials and a state research institute after German authorities accused Russia of poisoning Navalny with a nerve agent. Russia has described the sanctions as "unacceptable and unfounded" and said the expanded list of banned UK nationals was made in response to "unconstructive and unfriendly actions of the British authorities." Last week the ministry announced a similar response to the EU sanctions.

COMMENT The UK Russia Sanctions Regulations 2019 came fully into force on the 31 December 2020. The government website says "They are intended to ensure that certain sanctions relating to Russia continue to operate effectively. This sanctions regime is aimed encouraging Russia to cease actions destabilising Ukraine or undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty or independence of Ukraine." More sanctions have also been applied because of the poisoning of the Russian opposition leader Alexai Navalny. Russia has responded with its own sanctions on the UK. The Bible speaks of the king of the south (UK / US) pushing / provoking the king of the north (Russia). We see this happening and the "push" will one day lead to Russia attacking.

America's unprecedented and explosive year in politics

As 2020 ends, so does one of the most explosive and unprecedented years in American politics. Fires, floods, hurricanes, and locusts: 2020 was an epic year for disasters

The Covid-19 pandemic was unfortunately not the only natural disaster of 2020. There were so many that it's easy to forget everything that happened this year. Here is a brief sampling of 2020's weather-related events: The year began with a series of bushfires in Australia that forced thousands to flee, killed at least 29 people and more than a billion animals. The fires that sent smoke around the world had ignited amid weeks of record-breaking heat and drought. Swarms of locusts descended on East Africa, the Middle East, and South Asia, threatening food supplies for millions of people in the spring. The swarms were triggered in part by torrential rainfall in East Africa. This summer, California experienced its worst fire season on record in terms of area burned, as well as its largest single wildfire on record. Colorado also had its largest wildfire in history, and blazes in Washington and Oregon created an unprecedented disaster. A record number of wildfires this summer swept through the Pantanal, the world's largest tropical wetlands, spanning Bolivia, Brazil, and Paraguay.

COMMENT

2021 has begun and many people hope that 2020 will soon be forgotten and that the world will enter a much better time. However we know the "better time" will only come with the return of our Lord Jesus Christ from heaven. Until then it will not get better — we have not yet entered the "time of trouble such as never was". That is still to come. 
